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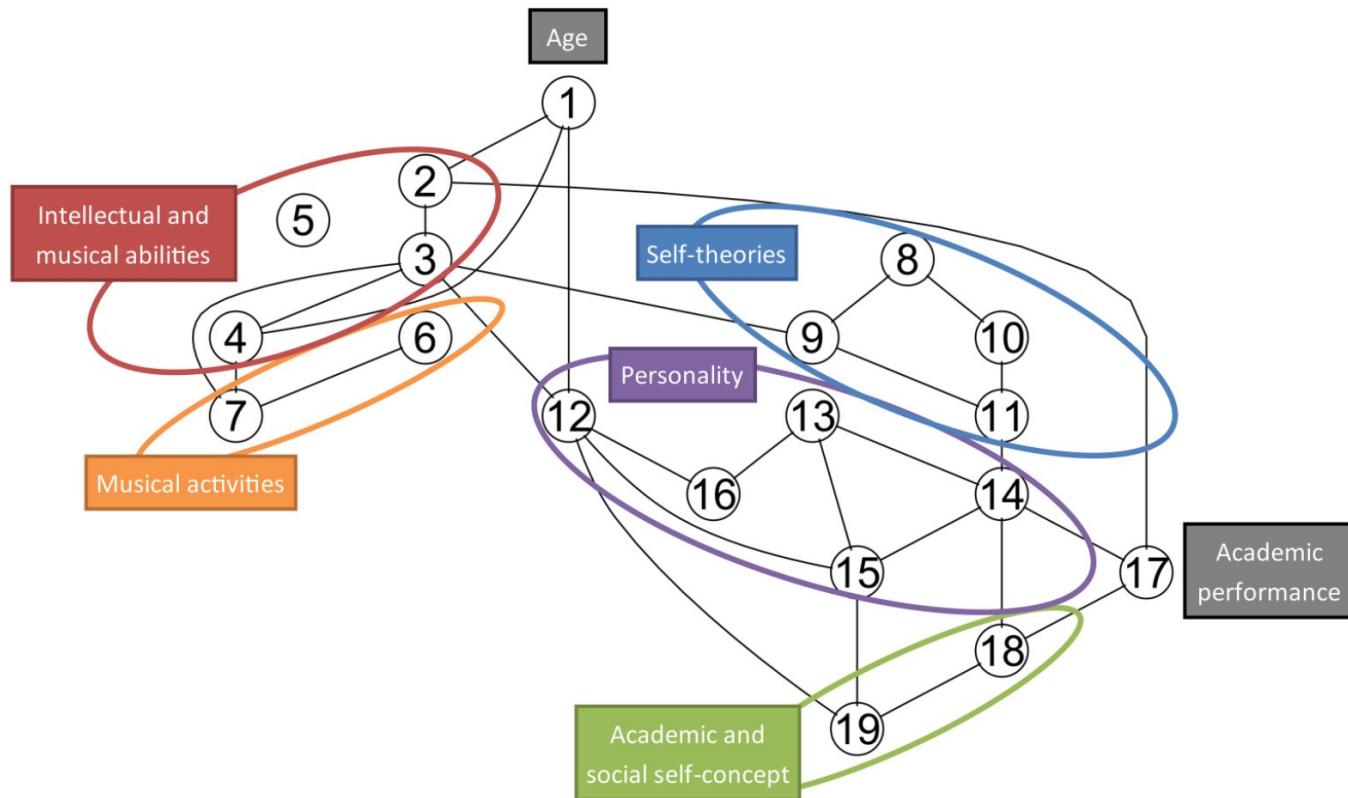

# Methode - Messinstrumente

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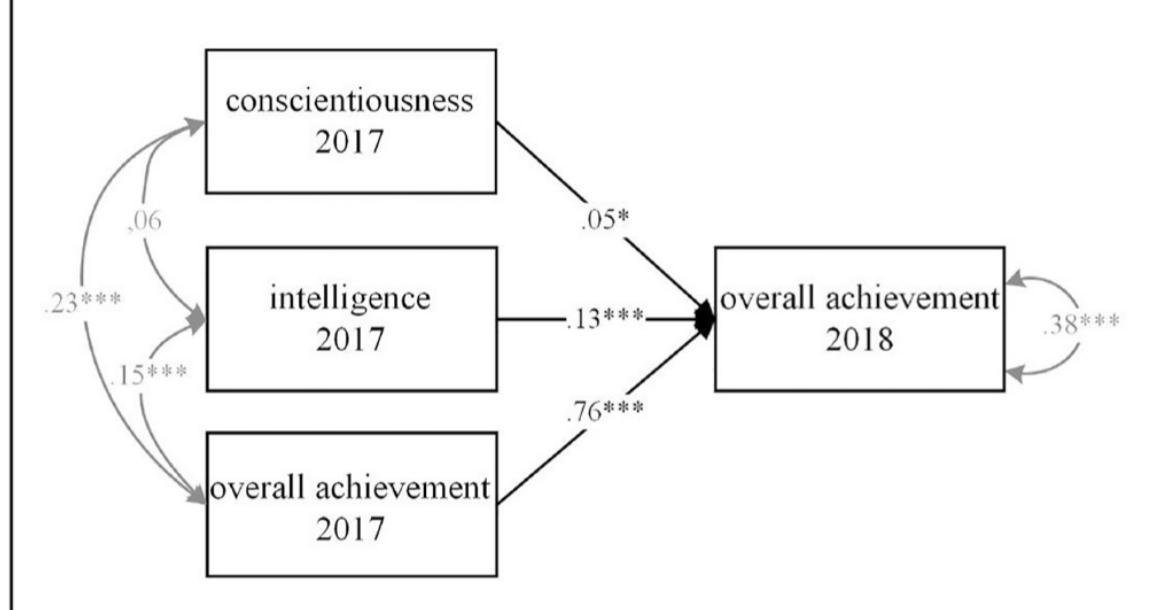
- Persönlichkeitsmerkmale:

- N = 564 (Allgemeine Leistung: Schulnote Durchschnitt)
- N = 317 (Musikalische Leistung: Schulnote Musik)

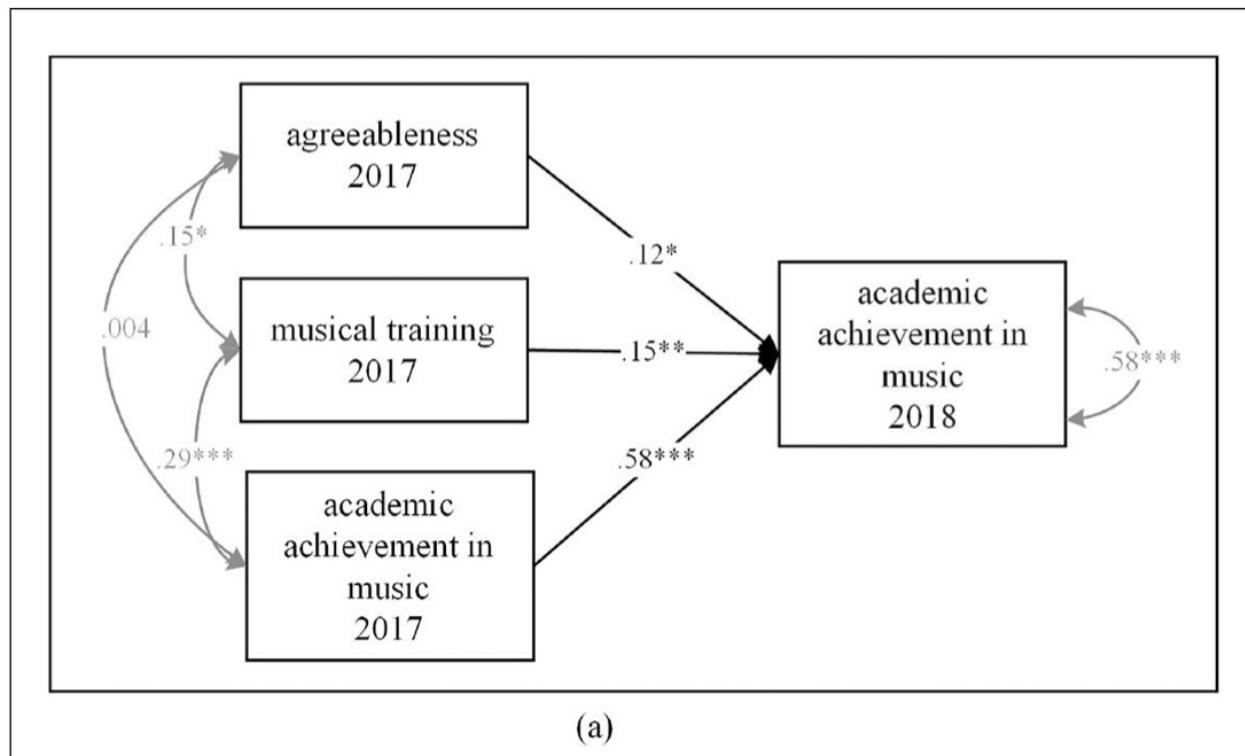

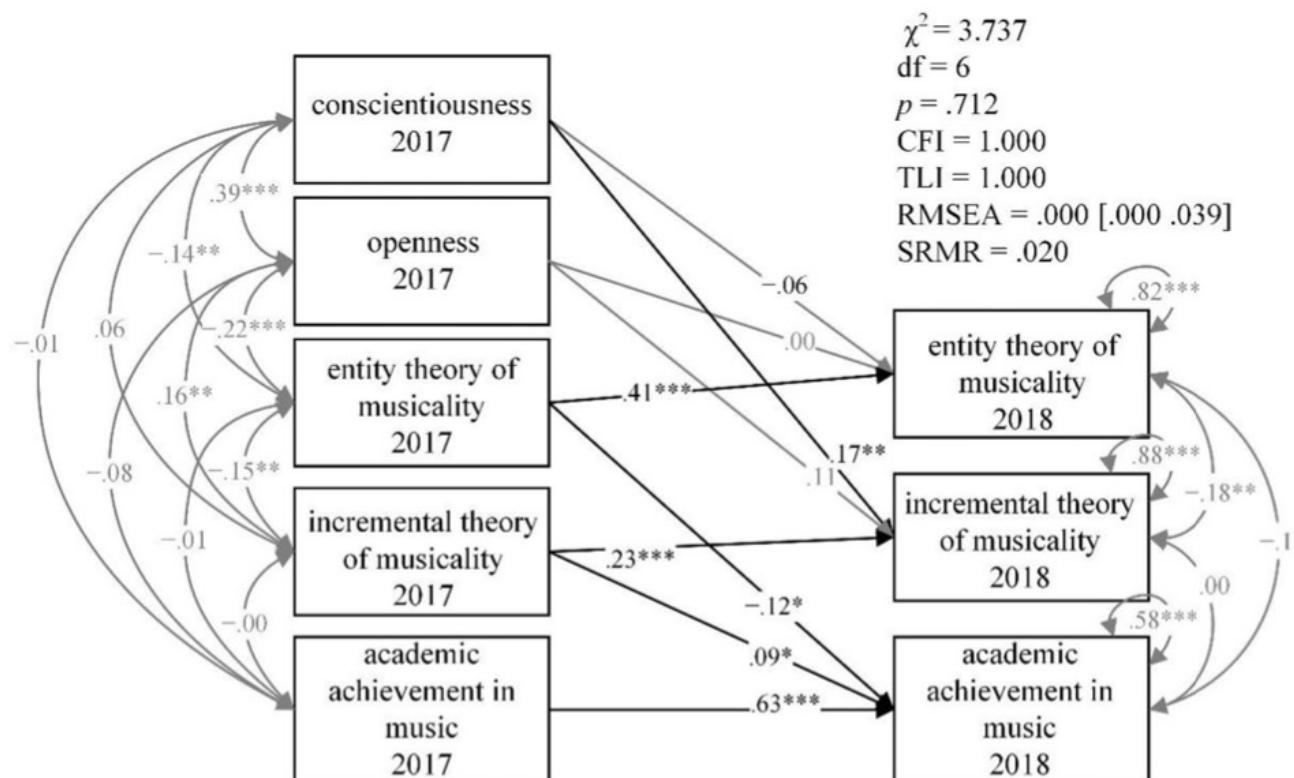
